

LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds. Beyond any area defined by boundary fences, white-topped fence posts or white pegs. (Rule 27-1)

Ground under repair. Defined by blue stakes. (Rule 25-1)

Immovable obstructions. Trees which are defined by a stake or protective enclosure, fence stays and stile supports are to be treated as immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2b)

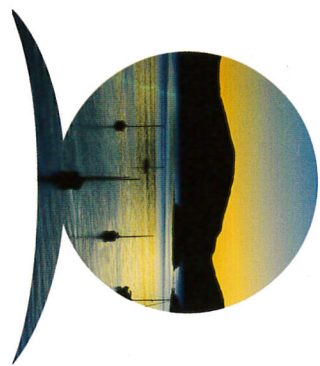
Stones. Except in a hazard, a ball lying on or amongst immovable stones may be treated as in an abnormal ground condition (Rule 25-1b(i)) and the exception apply).

Kelp, Ayers and Willows. In playing these holes, any ball which has crossed and remained beyond the margin of the lateral water hazard is deemed to be in the hazard (Rule 26 applies)

Yellow and red stakes mark water hazards and lateral water hazards respectively.

Use of course. The area adjacent to the No. 8 fairway is designated as a practice area. When a match is in progress, practice must not interfere with or distract players.

5 minutes is allowed to search for a lost ball. Call through the following group while searching, or losing a hole on the field.
